Our Holy Prophet ﷺ said, "مَن غَنْتَنَا فَلَيسَ مِنَّا", "He who cheats us is not of us." Anyway, people deceive themselves first. There are two ways, either you are with us or you are not. This the main thing, you are either with Allah ﷺ or with the shaytan; nothing else. May Allah ﷺ protect us insha'Allah. The evil of our ego is big, so may Allah ﷺ protect us from the evil of our ego and not lead us away from sincerity. May we be with sincere people.
