And then people will go astray again, and resurrection will take place. It cannot be otherwise.

There are various events, as we are living in the end of times. After distress there will be relief, and the promise of Allah 'Azza wa Jalla will manifest. We look and see that it is impossible not to be sad at the condition of Muslims. But these must certainly happen in order for this light to come out. This light is a beauty from Allah 'Azza wa Jalla. People who are given it are lucky. May Allah <sup>48</sup> make this light last upon us. And may this light come to this world very soon.
