### HONORING OUR HOLY PROPHET (SAW)

Hadrat Sulayman Chalabi says of the 12th night that it is equivalent to Laylatul Qadr. It is truly so. Allah created the universe for our Holy Prophet (SAW). The foreign giaour<sup>4</sup> made a fake birthday that is not upto much for Isa Alayhis Salam. It is not even his birthday. He was born on another date, but because it was winter time, there was no work to be done, they made it a pastime during this season. They say it is the birthday of Isa Alayhis Salam and prepare for it months ahead of time. In their cities, it says 90 days are left. Subtracting every day 89, 88 until the day they call his birthday arrives.

We need to remind and introduce the month of Rabiul Awwal to everybody. What is meant by Rabiul Awwal is spring in Arabic. Afterall, our Holy Prophet (SAW) was born in spring, on 21 April. However, our Islamic festivals are not done according to the Gregorian calendar but according to the Islamic calendar. Essentially now, we need to show more importance. Now we need to warn and awaken people more. It has become a fashion to celebrate the Sacred Birth Week in April. We are not opposing it because it is done for our Holy Prophet (SAW), but the real blessed and good deed is the month of Rabiul Awwal. It is better and more blessed to do more good deeds, to recite mawlid, and make salawat. May Allah (JJ) engrave<sup>5</sup> the love of our Holy Prophet (SAW) on our hearts. May we do all our thinking according to him Inshallah. May his gaze be upon us. May his blessings be upon us. Becasue every goodness is with our Holy Prophet (SAW). May Allah be pleased with you all.
