“Alhamdulillah,” the Glorious¹ Koran starts with this beautiful verse.

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ

“Alhamdu Lillahi Rabbil alamin.” (Sura Fatiha:2)
