[As for] you, be grateful for the blessings and be thankful. Thank Him. Take care of your iman and keep it strong, because a person reaches perfection by faith. A man without iman has no value, no acceptance, and is unworthy of regard. Being held in regard means being accepted in the sight of Allah.

It is not important to be accepted by other people. You could be someone weak and unremarkable in the sight of men, but that would not be important. What is important is

to have acceptance in sight of Allah. That is why it is not important to be upset about whether this or that person likes me and another doesn't. Have Allah like you

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and love you. This is sufficient. That is the most important thing anyway. May Allah give us all faith, and may we become His beloved servants, insha'Allah.
