## **OUR DUTY IS TO WORSHIP ALLAH**

Assalamu Alaykum wa Rahmatullah wa Barakatuh, Auzu Billahi Minashaytanir Rajeem. Bismillahir Rahmanir Raheem, Wassalatu Wassalamu ala Rasulina Muhammadin Sayyidul Awwalin wal Akhirin, Madad Ya Rasulallah, Madad Ya As'habi RasuLillah, Madad Ya Mashayikhina, Sheykh Abdullah Daghestani, Sheykh Nazim al-Haqqani. A'ūdhu bi-Llāhi mina sh-shayṭāni r-rajīm. Bismi Llāhi r-Raḥmāni r-Raḥīm:

(Qur'ān 22:77). Allah states in the Holy Quran: 'O you who have believed, bow and prostrate and worship your Lord and do good - that you may succeed.' Our duty is to worship Allah and do good works and deeds, this is our first obligation. That is why we start the day with the morning prayer (Fajr), worshipping Allah so it may be a means for goodness. In the past, people of old times would remember and mention Allah with every step, that's why there was barakah (blessing) and benefit in everything. Now barakah (blessing) has been lifted, they sow thousands of hectares of fields with tractors but it's of limited blessing and is of no much use in the end. Allah is showing us this so that we don't live in vain. You could get along with a little bit and save yourself, but if everything was yours perhaps you won't be able to save yourself.

Therefore, the first obligation for everybody is prayer and obedience to Allah . Nowadays, when people wake up they can easily pray morning prayer (Fajr) before going to work. If they don't pray, they will have to pray Qaḍā' prayer and make it up later. But if they don't do it here [in this world], they'll have to make it up in the hereafter. They would be living in vain in this world and in the hereafter. Because if they leave this world with faith, they will have to pray the missed prayers first and then they will go to heaven.

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Whereas in this world, and in five minutes, a person can easily wash his face and hands, perform Wuḍū' (ablution) and pray, but shaytan is teaching people laziness. They do everything but when it comes to worship they become lazy. May Allah give us guidance and keep us steadfast on this path insha'Allah.
