And then there are those who do it secretly, Allah ﷻ knows of that and He will accordingly give them their punishment. So if you don't want to be punished by Allah ﷻ, be in goodness. Stay with goodness and stay away from evil and from all sorts of badness. There are more than 800 types of evil, it was said. There are 800 types of evil and 500 types of goodness, but now perhaps it's more than 800 in these end times. Therefore, be careful.

May Allah ﷻ protect us and keep us gathered with the good ones. May He send us good people insha'Allah so we may be with the good ones. May we be far away from the bad ones and may Allah ﷻ reform them. May He keep us away from them if they're not



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to be reformed. Be with the ones who need goodness insha'Allah. Thank Allah ﷻ for this day of ours, this blessed day of Jumah (Friday).
